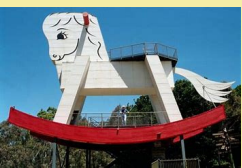

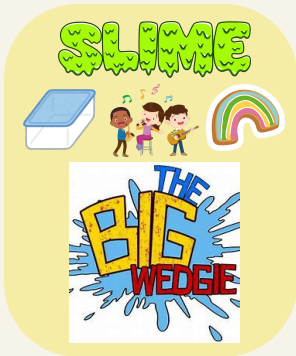

Booking Information:

- The Vacation Care Program may be subject to change without notice due to circumstances beyond the control of the Torrensville Primary School OSHC.
- Families must have outstanding OSHC fees up to date to access Vacation Care.
- All bookings must be paid via direct debit the following week of care.
- Vacation Care is subject to availability and staffing arrangements.
- Families can apply for Child Care Subsidy discount by registering through My Gov.

Cancellation:

- No cancellations during Vacation Care, all unattended bookings will be noted as absent.
- Swapping days before the holiday period is permitted, please contact the OSHC to discuss (*conditions apply*).

Key Information

Food and Drink:

- Please pack a healthy recess, lunch and snacks along with water bottle each day.
- Allergies at OSHC, please do not send nuts or foods containing nuts (**we are nut free**).
- Breakfast is available each morning between 7:30am-8:20am.
- Afternoon tea is served each day between 3:00pm-4:30pm.

Clothing, Footwear and Sun Protection:

- Please ensure children are dressed in appropriate clothing, sun smart on warmer days (no singlets), jumpers and jackets on cold and rainy days.
- Please ensure children wear appropriate footwear (no thongs or slides)
- Children are required wear a hat each day (caps are not an acceptable hat).
- OSHC provides 50+ sunscreen for children, if you require a specific type of sunscreen please supply it.
- Families are asked to apply sunscreen to children prior to arriving at OSHC.
- Please pack a spare change of clothes and shoes for play and in the event of an accident.
- All aquatics excursions require children to be sun smart, wearing a t-shirt or rashie top over bathers.
- Ensure all clothing is named and labelled.

Excursions, Transport and Safety:

- The bus company we use has seatbelts, all children and educators are required by law to wear them.
- Excursion departure times are specified on the program.
- Excursions may include lunch and play at a local park after programmed activity.
- Children will be back to OSHC for afternoon tea between 3:30pm-4:00pm, unless specified on the program.
- Risk assessments available at OSHC.
