Take this list of ideas to some of the OBBY locations and trial any of the activities below, or make up your own. ### Some ideas to try:

Create a picture or pattern on the ground using any loose natural materials that you can find.

Use mud to create dot pictures that describe your surroundings.

Use natural materials like grasses to make your own rope.

Gather different ingredients and make potions, perfumes or mud pies.

Collect fallen leaves and string them together with grass to make a necklace.

Go with your family to pick up litter you find in your natural area (don't forget safety first so wear gloves or use tongs).

Write a poem or story about your surroundings and how they make you feel.

Make a musical instrument from natural materials.

Make a cubby from fallen branches and other natural materials.

Go on a bug hunt - how many can you find?

Look for different textures - can you find something soft, rough, fluffy, spiky, smooth?

Listen to the birds - how many different birds can you hear?

How many animal homes can you find? Animals may live in hollows, under rocks, in holes in the ground or in trees and lots of other places.

Use a small rock to make drawings on bigger rocks. Notice how different rocks creates different kinds of markings.
